Anticipation guides can help students consider the conceptual message of the lesson Explicitly teaching the use of Anticipation Guides: Step 1 The first step is to create an anticipation guide Write statements that focus on the information in the text that you want students to think about

What is a Reading Anticipation Guide?

Responses to anticipation guides should be hand-written This ensures the students' work is their own Require responses to anticipation guides to be paraphrased from the text rather than quoted This encourages students to interpret, rather than simply copy, information from the text Attach the anticipation guides to a grade for your

Anticipation Guides One strategy that utilizes prediction and attempts to capitalize on controversy is the Anticipation Guide (Bean, Readence, & Baldwin, 2007) The anticipation guide can be used to activate prior knowledge before reading, encourage readers to use that prior
