1 Draw the shape of your head as if it does not have hair (1) 2 Halfway from the top of the head to the chin draw a line (it is on this line where your eyes will be drawn) Draw this line lightly 3 Draw a vertical line down the center of the head This will help keep the features lined up correctly Draw this line lightly 4
