A Guide To Oppositional Defiant Disorder

ODD [oppositional defiant disorder]— A disruptive pattern of behavior in children and adolescents that is characterized by defiant, disobedient, and hostile behaviors directed toward adults in positions of authority The behavior pattern must persist for at least six months

oppositional or defiant temperament MI creates a nonjudgmental environ-ment that allows the adolescent to talk openly about behaviors and beliefs Practice reflective listening to com-municate understanding When your patient describes a behavior with a negative health impact, temporarily

compartmentalize and hold off on voicing your concerns
