Case management for Medicaid-eligible pregnant women Targeted case management is limited to in-state providers only Providers of targeted case management to children younger than 21 who are not eligible for DDS must be an MSW, RN, LPN, LSW, Licensed Psychiatric Technician Nurse, or a master’s degree certified School Guidance
