limachus' allusions to early Greek poetry, can refer as much to context and content as to diction alone Stylistic mannerisms, however skilfully deployed, can only impart a general tone to a passage or poem; specific allusions have a much more pointed effect Consider, for example, Catullus' poem on his brother's grave (101):
