Seasonal Climate Forecast Nov. 2020 -Jan. 2021

Forecast Highlights nThe analog-years (1959-60; 1970-71; 1995-96) are unchanged from last month Both 1970-71 & 1995-96 had La Niña events, during the fall and winter period, but 1959-60 stayed ENSO-neutral nHigher-than-normal amplitude in the upper-air patterns is likely, but the placement of the mean ridges and troughs will vary monthly
