Some well-accepted observations regarding fractures of the scaphoid are that some fractures are not visible on standard radiographs; there is a 5 to 10 percent nonunion rate with non-operative treatment; and nonunions are usually symptomatic and always lead to arthrosis1,2 The idea that even invisible scaphoid fractures can fail

The fractures healed in 35(80%) of the 44 patients, as shown in Fig 3 Five (625%) of the eight fractures in the proximal third of the scaphoid healed and 30 (83%) of the 36 fractures in the middle and distal third,,; healed with electrical treatment Fractures of eight (89%) of the nine patients who had avascular necrosis

Reconstruction of Scaphoid Nonunion Fractures of the ...

Seventy-five (22%) patients received scaphoid reconstruction with a vascularized bone graft from the distal radius. Five patients were lost in follow-up.
