Symptom screening is a way employers can lower the chance of COVID-19 transmission in the workplace Screening will not identify people not showing symptoms yet, or who may be infected but show no symptoms Infection prevention in the workplace is important to prevent the spread of COVID-

Requirements for Bars and Nightclubs Not Operating as a ...

Implement symptom screening for employees prior to the start of their shift • Conduct wellness/symptom checks, which may include temperature checks for all bar personnel, prior to the start of their shift Assign duties to vulnerable workers that minimize their contact with customers and other employees

State of California Health and Human Services Agency ...

School staff are essential workers, and staff includes teachers, para-professionals, cafeteria workers, janitors, bus drivers, or any other school employee that may have contact with students or other staff School districts and schools shall test staff periodically, as testing capacity permits and as practicable
