Parents' Influence on Child Social Self-Efficacy and ...

Social cognition is an additional interpersonal interaction variable, which refers to the manner in which children analyze and interpret social behavior (Forrester, 1992) Similar to self-efficacy, social cognition develops experientially through interactions with important others in early childhood (Forrester, 1992) Both social self-efficacy
