Today Chol is spoken by some 65,000 people, of whom almost half are monolingual in this Indian language The majority of these Chol speakers live in the north of the state of Chiapas: in the highlands of Chiapas, in Tila, Tumbala and Sabanilla; in the lowlands, in the municipalities of Saito de Agua and Palenque Generally,
