body functions The nervous system controls your emotions, movements, thinking, and behavior Structurally, the nervous system is divided into two parts—the central nervous system [CNS](the brain and the spinal cord) and the peripheral nervous system [PNS](the smaller branches of nerves that reach the other parts of the body)(see Figure 61)

Our bodies require oxygen in order to metabolize glucose This process provides energy for the cells The brain consumes about a fifth of the body's total oxygen supply, and needs energy to transmit electrochemical impulses
