Titled "The Creators", this chapter takes an in depth look at the talented, and sometimes colorful, sculptors who shaped the unique character of the Met Area's classic golf courses. Another section explores those courses that are no longer in existence with a section called "Land That Time Forgot." The last section lists the Association's 99 years of champions, award winners and leaders - a real who's who of American golf.
