Passion for healing forges leaders of military medicine

The use of spear as a military weapon can be traced back to the Shang Dynasty some 4,000 years ago, by then the spearhead was quite broad and made of bronze.. Entering the Warring States era (475 BC – 221 BC), the iron or steel spearheads became more common, and were narrower in shape, while the shafts were often made of wood wrapped with bamboo sheets that improved strength and resilience.
