The History of the mRNA Vaccines – The History of Vaccines

In 2009, the results of the largest HIV vaccine trial in history were announced. Referred to as “RV144” or “the Thai trial” (as it took place in Thailand), it had more than 16,000 participants and took six years to complete. The trial used a “prime-boost” strategy with two experimental HIV vaccines.
